Wilma Rudolph (1940 – 1994)

3x Gold Medalist (Rome 1960)
1x Bronze Medalist (Melbourne 1956)

Wilma Rudolph is one of the most notable Olympians of the 20th Century. Her origin story as a young child with Polio has grown to be an inspiration to many. She was the first American woman to ever win 3 gold medals (Track & Field) at a single Olympic Games. In doing so, she also broke 3 world records. She was also a pioneer and civil rights activist. Her welcome home parade is noted as the first full integrated city event in Clarksville's history. Over the years, she has inspired many athletes, women, and social rights leaders.
