What is Transitional Services?

It supports the McKinney-Vento Homeless Act.

It ensures students can enroll in and attend school regardless of their living situation.

Our Goal

To support students in attending school, continuing their learning and fully experiencing all that school has to offer.

A student is considered homeless if they lack
FIXED, REGULAR or ADEQUATE
nighttime residence.

What is Homelessness?

- Doubled-Up
- Homeless Shelter
- Hotel
- Car, Park, Empty Building

Transitional Services Provides

- Transportation
- School Supplies
- Clothing
- Personal Care Items
- Resources for Housing, Jobs, Dental, Doctor, Eye Care

By The Numbers

- 360 District 742 Students Enrolled 2025-2026
- 810 District 742 Students Enrolled 2024-2025
- Majority are Doubled-Up
- Enrolled Students miss nearly 1 in 5 days of school
- Approximately 20,000 students in Minnesota enrolled

Innovation 2026-2027

- Form strategy for finding qualifying students
- Pilot attendance support program
- Operationalize distribution of resources
- Implement documentation of communication plan
