**AGENDA ITEM:** Consider Approval of Purchase of NWEA's Measure of Academic Progress (MAP) Growth

**PRESENTER:** Candace Summerhill, Director of Assessment and Accountability

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- Per Board Policy CH (Legal/Local), purchase of goods or services valued at \$50,000, or more, shall require Board approval before a transaction may take place.
- During the 2025-2026 school year, the district utilized the NWEA's MAP Growth reading and math assessments to track growth and progress across the district in grades 3-8 and for targeted students in grades 9-12.
- The MAP Growth assessments are aligned to the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) and provide teachers and students with learning goals by subject area so that students can monitor their own progress in reading and math. The data from these assessments help guide the teacher in planning targeted intervention for students.
- For the 2026-2027 school year, the district is recommending the use of MAP Growth assessments as the district reading and math screeners for students in grades 3-8 and for targeted students in grades 9-12.
- The costs associated with purchasing MAP Growth for the 2026-2027 school year is as follows:
  - MAP Growth Student Licenses (4200 students) \$51,233
  - MAP Growth Foundations Online Annual License \$1,000
  - MAP Growth Report +1 hr Virtual Consulting \$1,000
  - Total \$53,233
- The Board first discussed this at the April 20, 2026 Regular Board Meeting.

### **FISCAL INFORMATION:**

Purchase cost of \$53,233 will be paid from Instructional Materials and Technology Allotment, Fund 410.
