Subject: Notice of Board Member Continuing Education Training Requirements Met

Background Information

Senate Bill 1566 changed the manner in which continuing education credit is reported for the Board. Each Board member must complete any training required by the State Board of Education. The training requirement consists of orientation, team building, and annual continuing education. SB1566 requires that the minutes of the last regular meeting before an election of trustees reflect whether each Board member has met the training requirements, exceeded the required hours of training, or is deficient in the requirements.

The Board president must also announce a statement that completion of the required annual training is an obligation and expectation of any Board member under the SBOE rule.

Attached is a tabulation of board members' continued education training hours. The minutes will show that all board members have completed the required number of continuing education training hours. Also attached is an overview of continuing education requirements for school board members provided by TASB.
