

EMERGENCIES

~~Emergency preparedness drills (bomb threats, civil disturbance, fire and severe weather) will be developed by the District. The District emergency preparedness plan will include procedures for cases of bomb threat, civil disturbance, fire and severe weather.~~

~~Close cooperation with other community agencies (fire department, law enforcement and civil preparedness) is expected. The Superintendent/Designee will establish communication with community agencies to properly and smoothly work with them.~~

~~More than one type of incident can cause a school building to be evacuated: fire, bomb threat, civil emergencies, natural disaster and so on.~~

~~Since no two instances are identical in any situation requiring building evacuation, a variety of conditions must be anticipated.~~

The Nye County School District will prepare and maintain a “Standardized Emergency Operations Plan” in compliance with State of Nevada “Model Plan” for the same as required by the NRS 392.600 as amended by AB 127 of the 2017 legislative session and as amended by future sessions.

~~The principal of each school will be responsible for such plans. Plans will be in written form, approved by the District office, and distributed to all building staff.~~

The Principal of each school will prepare the site specific annex/appendix for their site and will be responsible for its implementation, and training of staff and students.
