Process

Next Steps

- Onboard candidates as a Franklin employee.

 - Ensure new FCHS hires follow all FCS employee expectations.
 - Student and employer report each week to the state for reimbursement.
 - Provide ongoing professional development and mentorship while collaborating with FCHS.
