ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

ACTION REQUIRED

SUMMARY:

Interdistrict transfers (commonly referred to as IDTs) are student transfers between school districts. The local school district, by board action, determines the number of students it can accept from outside the district using Interdistrict transfer. Districts may decide to admit no students, any student who requests a transfer or set a limit on the number of students that will be admitted. Currently the district allows students on an IDT to continue their schooling with the district until graduation unless they withdraw from school. IDTs can be revoked by the receiving district for any of the following reasons: the student shows a pattern of violating school rules and regulations; the student has irregular attendance or chronic tardiness; or any information on the request is falsified. The sending district does not determine the length of time for which consent is given.

ACTION REQUESTED:

It is recommended the Board accept the following numbers for non-resident student admission for each grade level:

Kindergarten - 25	Sixth Grade - 6	Ninth Grade - 10
First Grade - 3	Seventh Grade - 16	Tenth Grade - 20
Second Grade - 15	Eighth Grade - 20	Eleventh Grade - 20
Third Grade - 10		Twelfth Grade - 20
Fourth Grade - 12		
Fifth Grade - 5
