Professional Learning

- August is packed with professional learning across HISD! We welcomed first-year teachers and new employees on August 3 with an introduction to district goals, initiatives, and resources. Campuses also had five dedicated workdays for classroom setup, required professional learning, and planning for the first two weeks of school. District PD on August 6–7 included 7 Habits Overview for new staff, Special Education Co-Teaching, paraprofessional training, IXL (Grades 1–8), Curipod (HJH & HHS), and K–4 science planning.
