Nutrition Services Report - August 19, 2026

Nutrition Services Updates:

- SFSP concluded with the last day being July 17th, 2026.
 - For the month of July (SFSP):
 - Breakfast = 265 meals served
 - Lunch = 373 meals served
 - Total = 638
 - Revenue: \$2,936.14
- The State of Idaho conducted a routine audit of our SFSP program. There were 2 minor findings, which were addressed immediately. Overall, the department was commended for the quality of menu variety, staff, service and compliance.
- At this time, the department is nearly fully staffed and ready to go for SY 26-27. We just need to fill a cook position and a dishwasher.
- Menus for the upcoming school year are complete and ready! We will be participating in seasonal promotions through the menus. "Pizza Daze" is the first of 4 quarterly promotions.
- FFVP grant awarded again this year, in the amount of \$42k. These funds will be used to provide fresh fruit and vegetable snacks to students at Spirit Lake Elementary and John Brown Elementary. This program will be rolled out again, shortly after the beginning of the school year, on October 6th, 2026.
- USDA commodity allocation this year for both DOD fruit and vegetables and standard commodity products is \$111,420. We did very well last year utilizing nearly all funds allocated for our district.
 - Left unutilized from \$94,011:
 - Brown Box - \$1
 - DOD Produce - \$7.80
- Our back-to-school all staff training meeting will be conducted on Wednesday, August 26th. This will be followed by a half day team lead training meeting on Thursday, August 27th.
