Board Goals for 2023-2028

- Goal 1*:** The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 49% to 60% by June 2024, 65% for 2024-2025, 70% for 2025-2026, 75% for 2026-2027, 80% for 2027-2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**
- Goal 2*:** Increased overall student performance in mathematics to 85% Meets Standard by 2028. The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 53% to 65% by June 2024, 70% for 2024-2025, 75% for 2025-2026, 80% for 2026-2027, 85% for 2027-2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**
- Goal 3*:**The percentage of graduates that meet the criteria for CCMR will increase from 72% to 88% by August 2024 and increase to 95% by 2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**

Summary: **The Board shall determine prevailing wage rates in the district for construction projects.**

Background Information:

Board Policy CV and Texas Government Code Ch. 2258 states that for a public work awarded by a district, the board shall determine the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the district for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the contract and the prevailing rate for legal holiday and overtime work by:

- **Conducting a survey of the wages received by classes of workers employed on projects of a character similar to the contract work in the district in which the public work is to be performed; OR**
- **Using the prevailing wage rate as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act (40U.S.C Section 276a et seq.), and its subsequent amendments.**

Navarro ISD has previously adopted the Prevailing Wage Rates (PWR) in the federal Davis-Bacon Wage Determinations for Guadalupe County.

Unfortunately, those rates exclude certain trades including Electrician Helper. At this time, the district needs to establish and adopt a PWR for this trade for the 2024 and 2025 Bond Construction Projects.

A contractor asked about the rates for these positions, but the Department of Labor does not provide rates for these categories. The Administration did its own review, and proposes the Board adopt the proposed rate separately for this category along with the Prevailing Wage Rates (PWR) in the federal Davis-Bacon Wage Determinations for Guadalupe County.
