

8210**SECURITY**

Buildings of the school district constitute one of the greatest investments of the school district. It is deemed in the best interest of the District to protect the investment adequately.

Security should mean not only maintenance of a secure (locked) building but also protection from fire hazards and faulty equipment and unsafe practices in the use of electrical, plumbing and heating equipment. The Board requires close cooperation with local police, fire and sheriff's departments and with insurance company inspectors.

The Superintendent/designee will provide such security services as deemed necessary to secure and protect all school property.
