- The 2025-2026 Ranger Athletics are in the final stretch as our Spring Sports wrap up their regular season and prepare for the postseason.

Athletics Updates**Baseball**

- The Ranger Baseball team is currently 7-9 on the season and are 5-6 in Great River Conference play. They have battled some injuries as of late but are hoping to have a fully healthy roster when the Postseason starts. If they finish strong the last week of the regular season they could finish above .500 for the first time in seven years. The Section 7AA playoffs will start on Tuesday May, 26th.

Boys Golf

- The Crosby-Ironton/Aitkin Boys Golf are finishing up their Great River Conference matches for the 2026 season and are in a great position to repeat as Team Champions. Three of them are ranked in the top 5 of Conference play (Bennett Sadlowsky, Louie Meyer & Matt Prethish) and they lead as a team. They are currently ranked 5th in Section 7AA and Bennet Sadlowsky is 9th individually. They are beginning to prepare for their Section 7AA Tournament that starts on May 27th.

Girls Golf

- Crosby-Ironton/Aitkin Girls Golf are also in their finishing stretches of Conference play where they are currently ranked 2nd and have three girls in the Top 5 individually (Svea Johnson, Natalee Samuelson and Hailey Doucette). They are ranked 6th in Section 7AA and that Tournament starts on May 26th.

Softball

- The Softball team finished up their regular season last week (two games remained when this report was submitted). Currently they are 3-15 on the season and are looking ahead to the Section Playoffs which begin May 19th. The young team has competed very hard this season and are continuing to grow and improve with each game.

Track & Field

- The Track & Field team competed last week at the Great River Conference Championships where nine Conference Championships were won and both teams finished in 2nd overall. Lucy Lewandowski won the Girls 100m & 200m, Sophia Strom won the Girls Shot Put, Ezra Jacobson won the Boys 400m & Pole Vault, Peter Bartels won the 3200m and three Relay Championships were attained (Boys 4x100m, Girls 4x200m, Girls 4x800m). The Sub-Section Championships are scheduled on Wednesday, May 21st.
