St. Michaels reviewed the following 15 policies proposed for revision: 208 (Policy Stewardship); 402 (Disability Nondiscrimination); 416 (Drug, Alcohol, and Cannabis Testing); 423 (Employee-Student Relationships); 425 (Staff Development); 509 (Enrollment of Nonresident Students); 521 (Student Disability Nondiscrimination); 524 (Internet, Technology, and Cell Phone Acceptable Use and Safety); 613 (Graduation Requirements); 621 (Literacy and The READ Act); 624 (Online Learning Options); 709 (Student Transportation Safety); 721 (Procurement); 722 (Public Data Requests); 806 (Crisis Management). St. Michaels reviewed the following policy proposed for adoption: 625(Responsible Use Of Artificial Intelligence). These policies will have a final reading and will be proposed for action at the September 28 business meeting.
