Grades 1 through 9

- Daily literacy instruction built around a placement assessment and small-group teaching
- Enrichment woven through every day: hands-on projects, movement, and exploration
- Field trips that extended learning beyond the classroom
- Grouped by grade bands to keep instruction targeted and engaging

Placement assessment

K-5 teachers assessed students early to place them into targeted literacy groups

Small-group instruction

Daily reading instruction tailored to each group's level

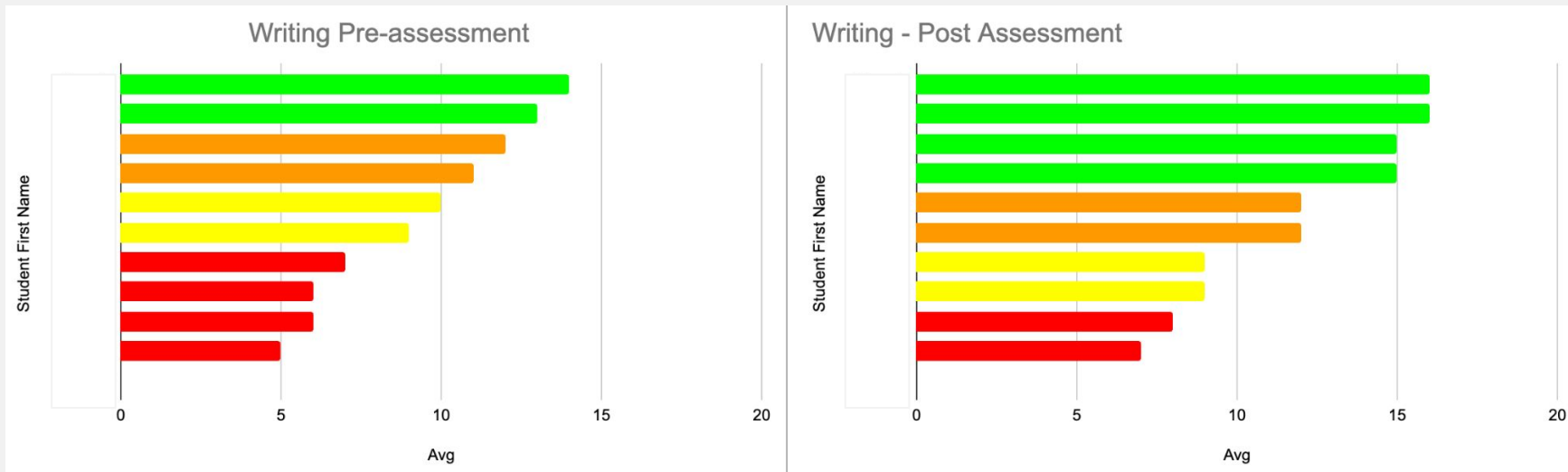
Research-based literacy resources
