STUDENT FUND - RAISING ACTIVITIES

Fundraising activities conducted by students, student clubs, school sponsored organizations, booster groups, Family Faculty Organizations, or other groups affiliated with or support a district school whether conducted on school premises or elsewhere as representatives of the school will be permitted ~~only when connected with specific school activities~~ once approved by the school Governing Board. Fundraising requests shall be reviewed and approved by the site administrator before they are submitted for Governing Board approval.

Participation in contests or fund-raising activities shall be governed by the following criteria:

- The aim of the activity shall benefit youth in educational, civic, social, and ethical development.
- The activity shall not interrupt the regularly planned instruction.
- Students shall not make door-to-door solicitations.
- Students shall not use a personal device to transmit personally identifying information of themselves and others to third party vendors in school-sponsored electronic fundraising activities.
- ~~Each recognized student group may raise up to fifty dollars (\$50) per student member per year up to a maximum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per organization per year with the approval of the building principal. Fund-raising beyond this amount must receive prior approval of the Governing Board.~~
- All fundraising activities conducted by recognized groups affiliated with or supporting a school or the district must receive prior approval from the Governing Board.
- A portion of the proceeds of all from any fundraising activities that directly involve student participation shall be deposited in the Student Activity Fund. and ~~Funds~~ deposited from such activities shall be used only as specified permitted in the Uniform System of Financial Records.
