Updates:

- The staff of RCES worked diligently to prepare RCES classrooms, grounds, and the building to prepare for the start of the 2026-2027 school year. Many staff members gave of their own time and worked alongside each other to ensure the classrooms and hallways were inviting, welcoming our students back for the new year. Their dedication and time were greatly appreciated!
- RCES held a back to school open house on Monday, August 10. First, third, and fourth graders visited from 4:30-6:00 while second and fifth grade students came from 6:00-7:30. We had an excellent turnout this year with a total of 580/689 first through fifth grade students attending the open house. In appreciation of their time and effort, Mrs. Fox made a homemade taco and nacho bar for staff to enjoy before or after their open house time slot.
- Our kindergarten meet the teacher event was held on Wednesday, August 12. Kindergarteners and their families came to visit their classroom for approximately an hour in a small group to meet the teacher, bring their school supplies, and begin the transition to kindergarten. The families spent approximately 35 minutes with the teacher helping the child acclimate to the classroom. Then, the students remained with their teacher where they traveled to the dining hall to be introduced to the lunchroom before having to experience breakfast in the busy environment the following morning. Meanwhile, the

parents joined Mrs. Fox in the library to be introduced to the routines and procedures of RCES as well as opening up the lines of communication between home and school. The event was widely attended with 118/123 students participating.

- On August 10- 11 during the school improvement days, teachers and staff received defined training to aid everyone in growing their craft as an educator or support staff member. In addition, staff was given ample time in their classrooms to collaborate and prepare for open house and the first day of school. Trainings included:
 - Intervention implementation and mClass training
 - Math and Literacy training
 - Introduction to being a support staff member at RCES
 - Special Education Collaboration and Planning
 - Safety Updates and Training
 - How to access and use counseling services for students
 - PALS introduction and support
 - Introduction to the mentoring program and New Teacher Academies
- All special education staff and their paraprofessional team received training on mClass interventions. This will be a new intervention layer that we will be adding to the special education classrooms this year. It will provide detailed instruction and support for students, while allowing for effective intervention and time saving for staff members. It will coincide with interventions being used across the building.
- ESGI was purchased for all special education teachers. This was a new tool that will aid them in efficiently tracking data.
