Work will include investigation of the existing roof assemblies; removal of failed roofing, wet insulation, and deteriorated materials; repair or replacement of roof decking as required; installation of new insulation and complete roofing membrane systems; and replacement of associated flashings, penetrations, curbs, drainage components, and edge conditions. Work will also include replacement of the existing high gym roof, with associated flashings, penetrations, curbs, and edge conditions.	X	\$2,000,000

Work will include reconfiguring the locker room layout to provide accessible circulation routes, installing ADA-compliant showers, restroom fixtures, and changing areas, and upgrading doors, hardware, and finishes to meet accessibility standards. These improvements will ensure equitable access for all users, address current code deficiencies, and extend the functional life of the facility.	X	\$400,000

In addition, the project will upgrade the school's fire alarm and suppression systems to meet current Alaska state fire codes, ensuring compliance and improving the overall safety of students, staff, and visitors. Upgrades will include replacing outdated lighting with modern, energy-efficient stage and house lighting systems; installing updated audio-visual and sound technology to support instructional programs and community events; and addressing deficiencies to bring the facility into compliance with current life-safety and accessibility codes. These improvements will enhance the educational experience, support school and community performances, and extend the useful life of the facility while ensuring compliance with applicable regulations. 6	C	Craig High School Flooring Replacement This project will replace 20-year-old carpet that has exceeded its useful lifespan, is worn and frayed, and has become a trip hazard. The project will address flooring throughout Craig High School, with the exception of the gymnasium. Work will include replacement of flooring in classrooms, offices, and other areas throughout the building, as well as the large CHS Commons area, where the existing flooring is also showing signs of failure, including a current crack. Flooring materials will be selected based on the use and needs of each area and may include carpet and vinyl flooring.	X	\$475,000
