COUNCIL MEMBER ----- INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLAIR, NEBRASKA, AWARDING ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000), FROM THE LOCAL OPTION MUNICIPAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (LB840) FOR THE EXPANSION OF A ROCK CRUSHING AND RECYCLING BUSINESS AT A NEW INDUSTRIAL SITE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Nebraska statute, the City of Blair is authorized to disburse certain funds received from the Local Option Municipal Economic Development Program (LB840) for the purpose, and in accordance with requirements, as set forth in the state statutes and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the LB840 Advisory Committee did meet on August 17, 2026, and reviewed the request from Henton Worx, LLC for a loan in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000); and

WHEREAS, the LB840 Advisory Committee did vote to approve the allocation of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to Henton Worx, LLC for the purpose of land acquisition, facility improvements, water service, a certified truck scale and additional infrastructure to expand operations of a rock crushing and recycling business at a new industrial site located on Tax Lot 67 in Section 19, Township 18, Range 12, and create six (6) new employment opportunities with maintenance of those jobs over a thirty-six (36) month period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLAIR: that One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) will be allocated from LB840 to Henton Worx, LLC for the purpose of land acquisition, facility improvements, water service, a certified truck scale and additional infrastructure to expand operations of a rock crushing and recycling business at a new industrial site.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the funding terms are as follows: 1) \$85,000 grant payable upon completion and 2) \$15,000 payable on completion for job creation, with the requirement that six (6) FTE's must be created within twelve (12) months and maintained for thirty-six (36) additional months. The \$15,000 will be fully forgivable if the required employment level is maintained for three (3) years.
