- Community Education & Recreation provided a wide range of recreation and enrichment opportunities for youth and adults this summer, with more than 2,300 enrollments in programs and over 22,000 visits to the Colvill Aquatic Center.

District administrative and building leadership staff actively participated in this comprehensive training, further strengthening our multi-agency coordination, crisis preparedness, and safety protocols across all facilities.
