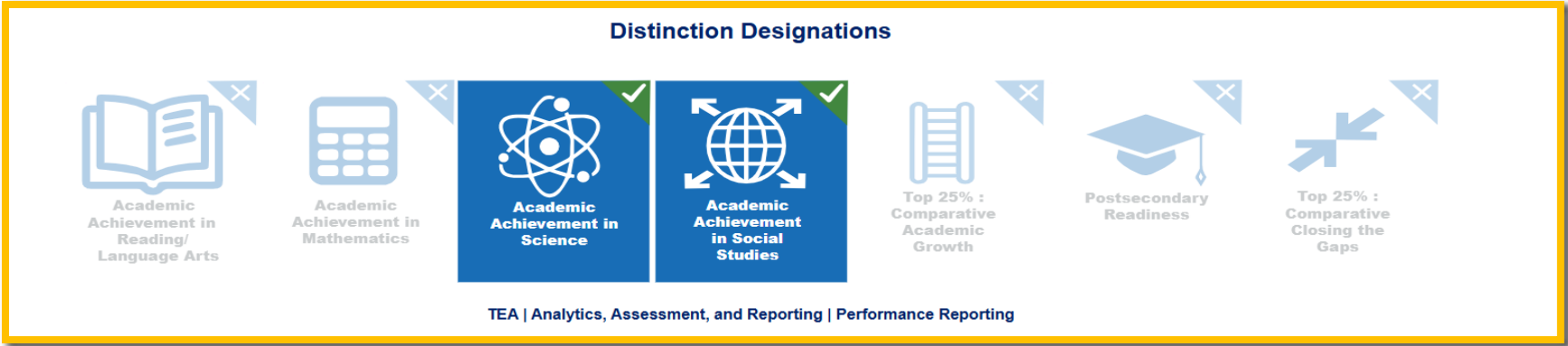
- Limited teacher ownership of instructional practices

- Ensure students have Math Foundational Skills

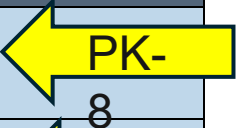
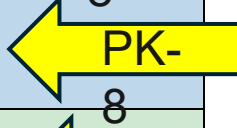
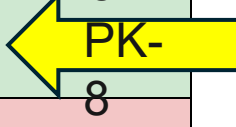
