2025-2026 STAAR Performance

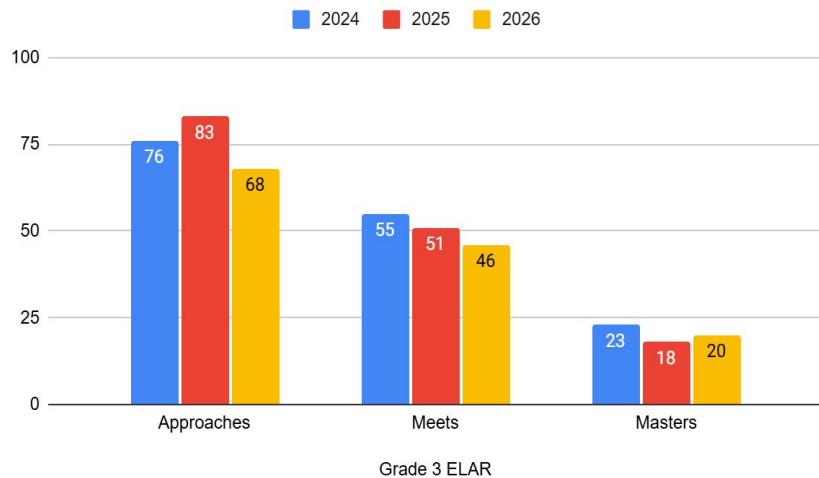
The following preliminary results are inclusive of all students who participated in STAAR assessments in 2025-26.

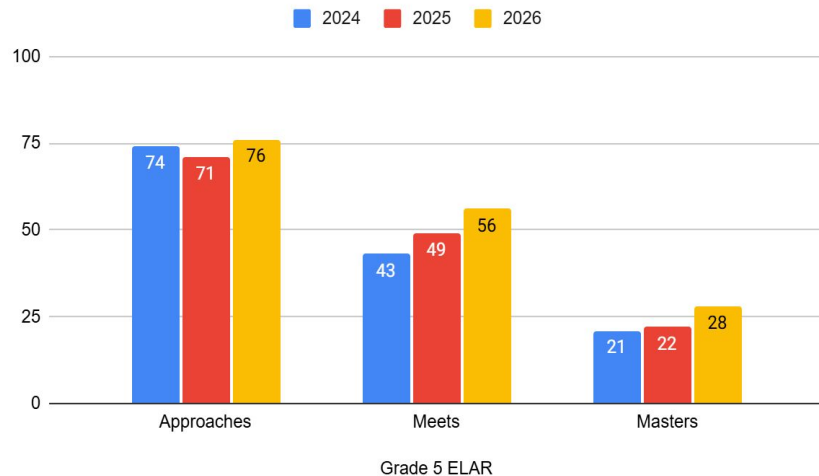

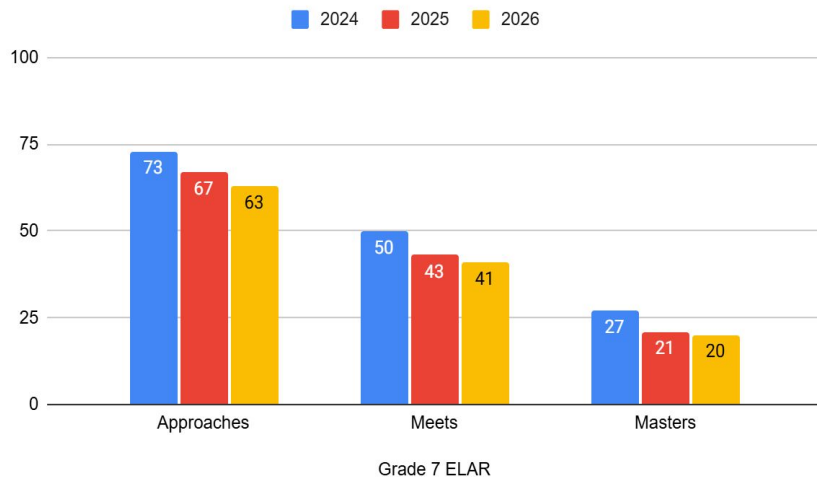

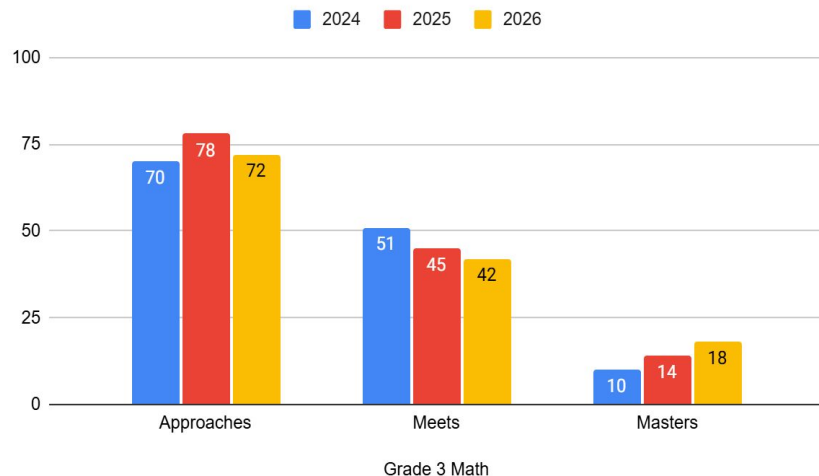

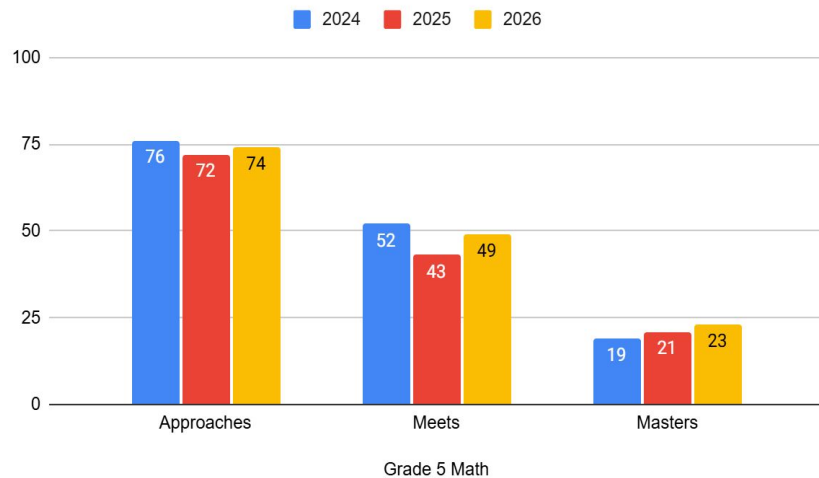

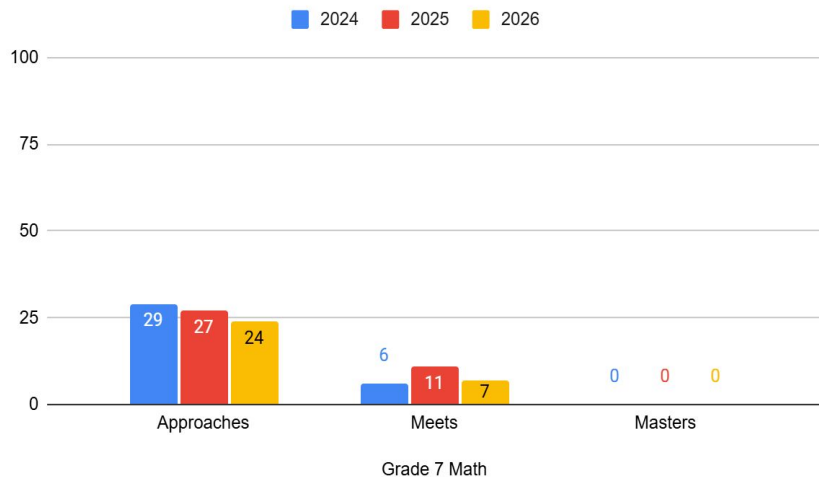

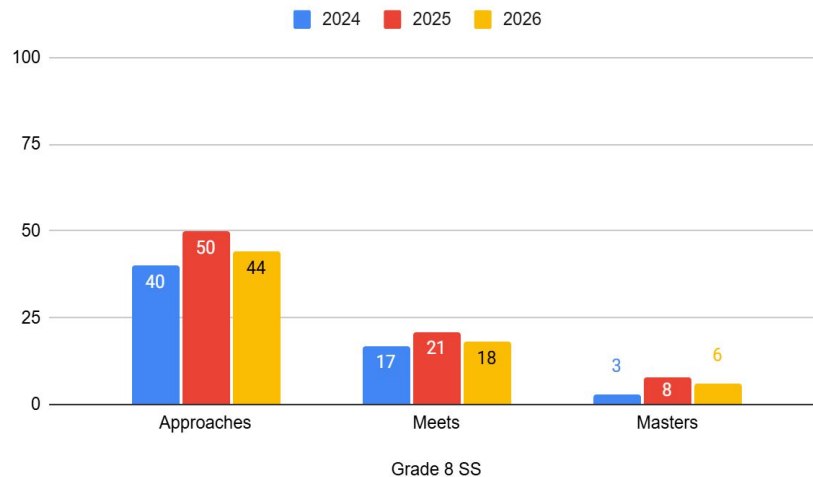

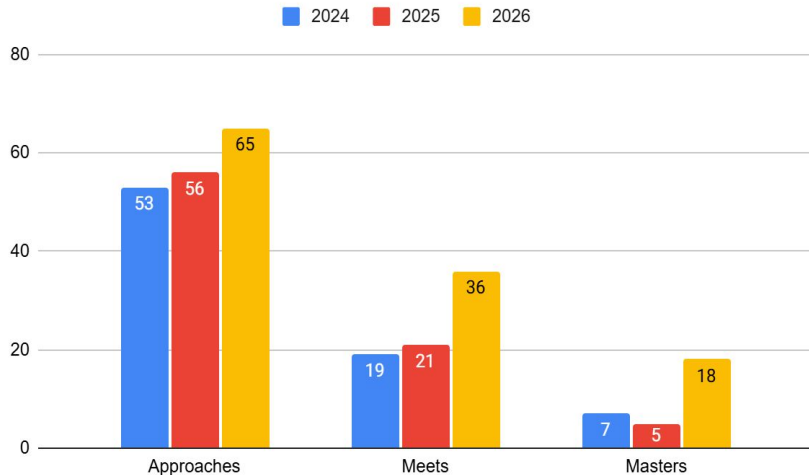

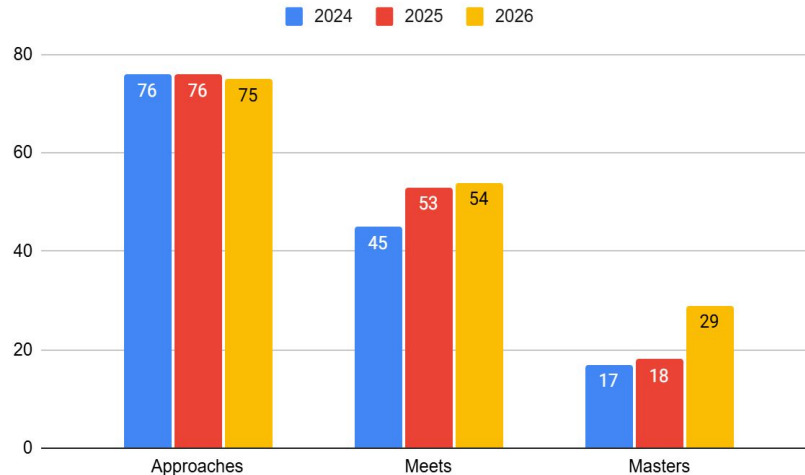

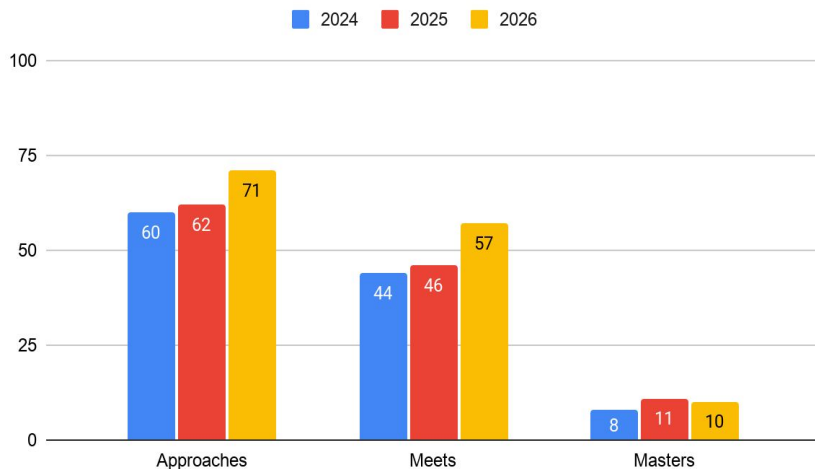

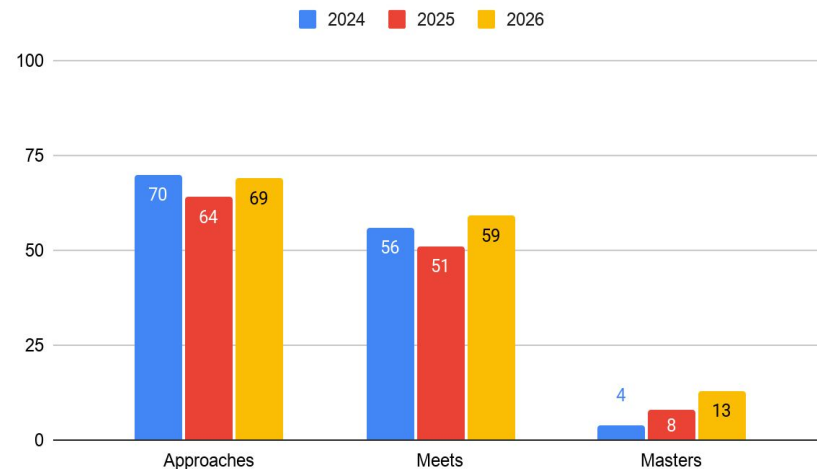

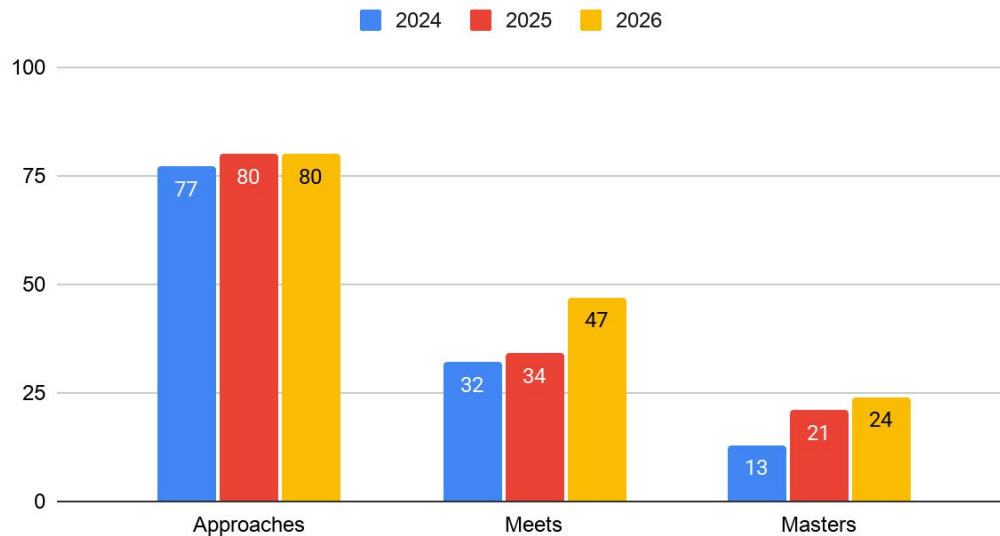

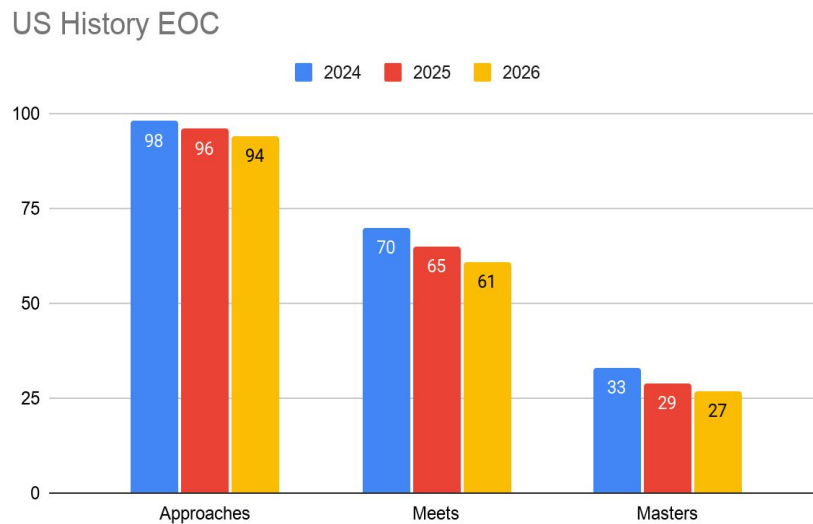

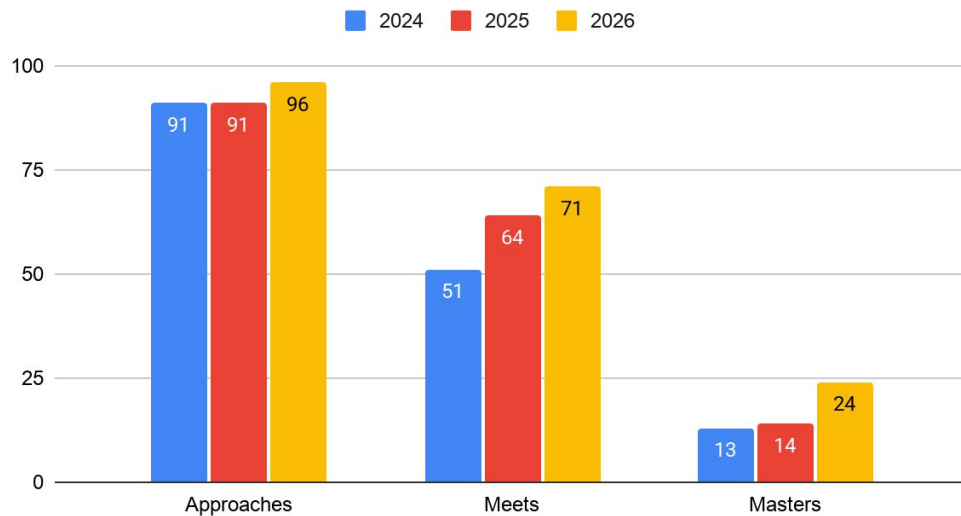

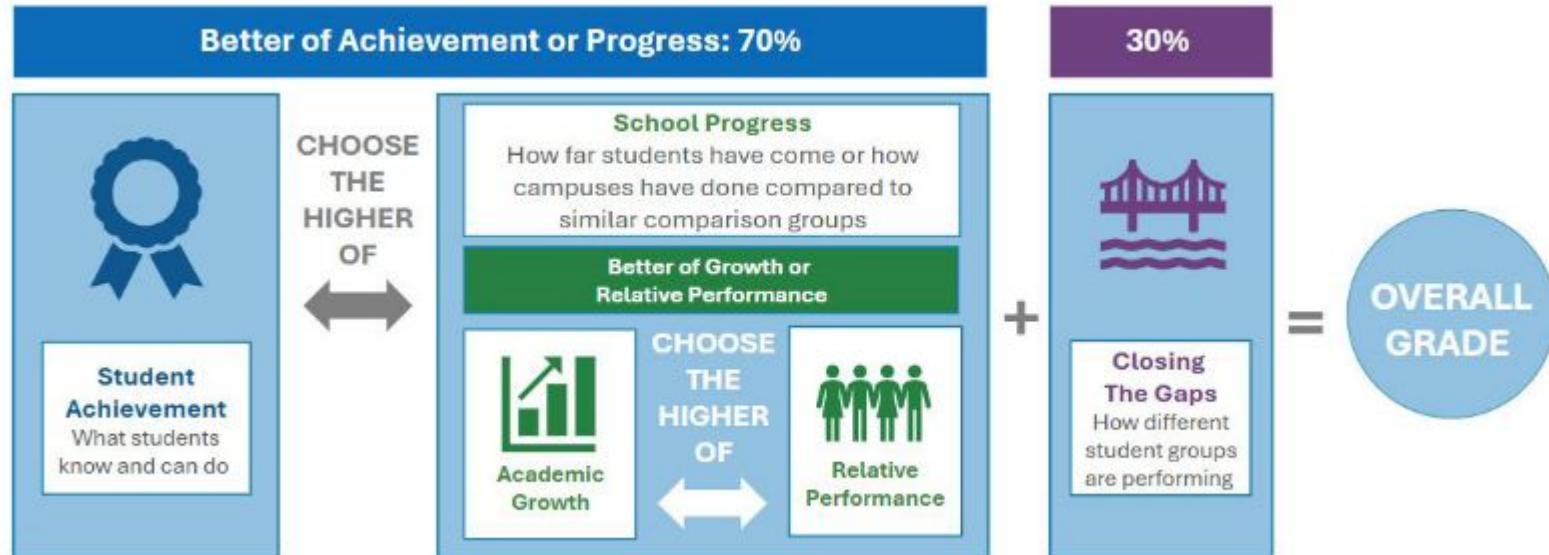
2026 SISD STAAR Takeaways

- Reading Language Arts continues to be a high-priority area of focus for improvement. SISD performance varied across grade levels, with some seeing declines (grades 3, 6, and 7) and others seeing gains (grades 4, 5, and 8).
- Mathematics saw gains at grade 5 and 6, with significant gains across performance levels in grade 8. SISD outperformed the state in Mathematics grades 3, 5, 6 and 8.
- Science performance improved significantly in grade 5 across all performance levels, and in grade 8 we saw gains in higher performance levels. In both grades 5 & 8, SISD outperformed the state at the approaches and meets levels.
- US History EOC performance was significantly higher than 8th grade Social Studies. Although US History EOC scores have shown a slight decline, SISD continues to outperform the state in this area.
- Biology, English I, and English II EOC performance improved greatly from the prior year.
- Algebra I performance at the Meets and Masters level showed excellent improvement.
- Overall, EOC performance is strong and continuing to improve over the last several years.

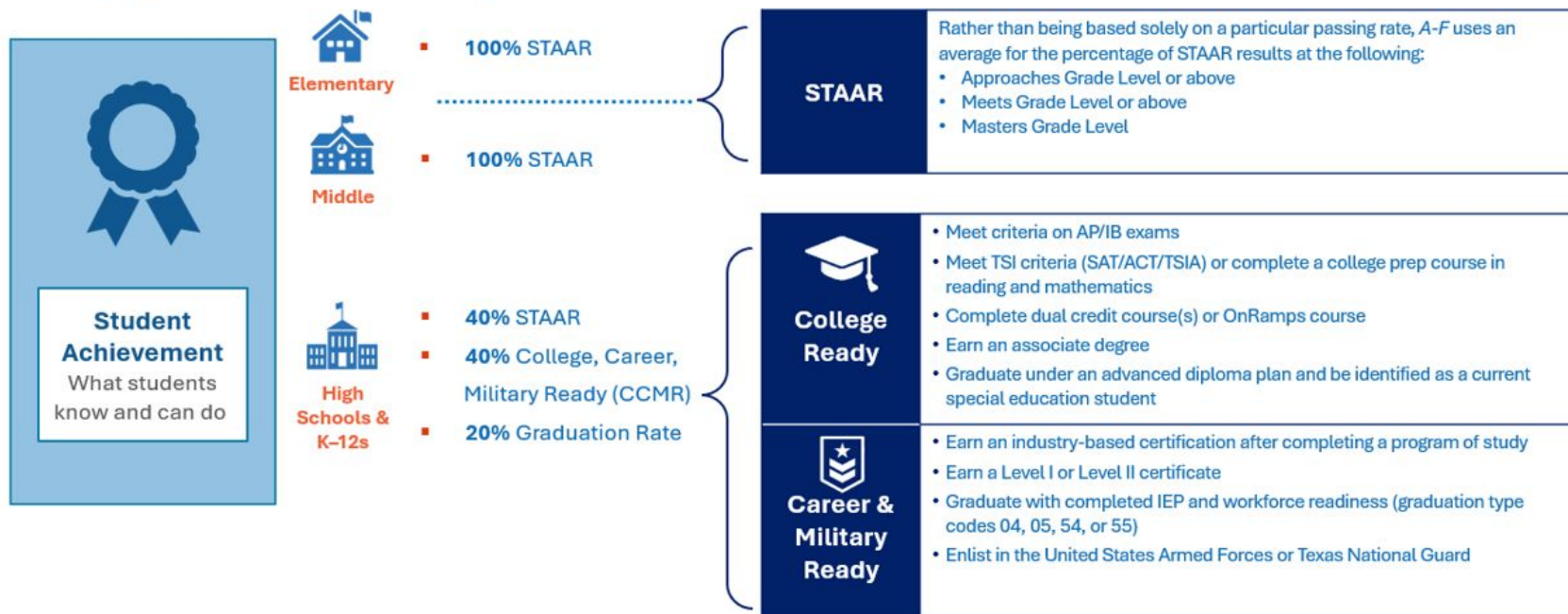
How Are Ratings Determined?



The 2026 TEA Accountability Manual is 278 page document that describes how the single overall letter grade is derived for districts and campuses in Texas.

Domain I : Student Achievement

Ratings in this domain are based on how many students are approaching, meeting, and mastering grade level on STAAR as well as how many students graduate and whether those graduates are ready for college, a career, or the military.



Domain II : School Progress Part A & B



The School Progress domain measures district and campus outcomes in two areas:

- The number of students that **grew at least one year academically** and number of students that were **accelerated** as measured by year-over-year STAAR results
- The achievement of students relative to campuses with **similar economically disadvantaged** percentages

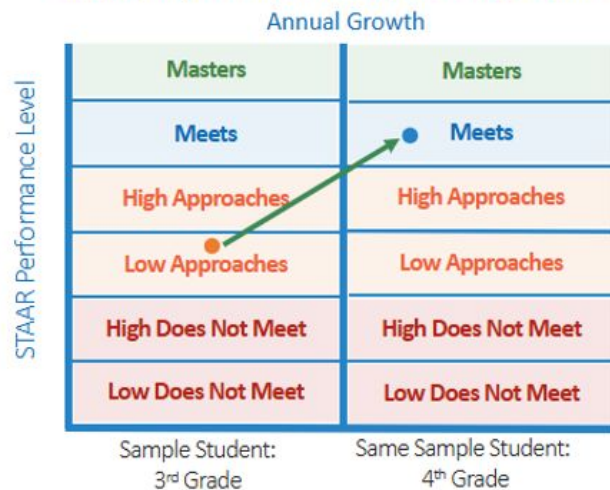

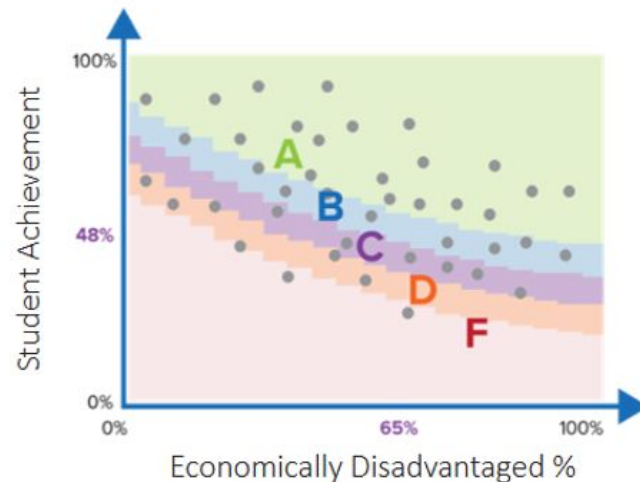

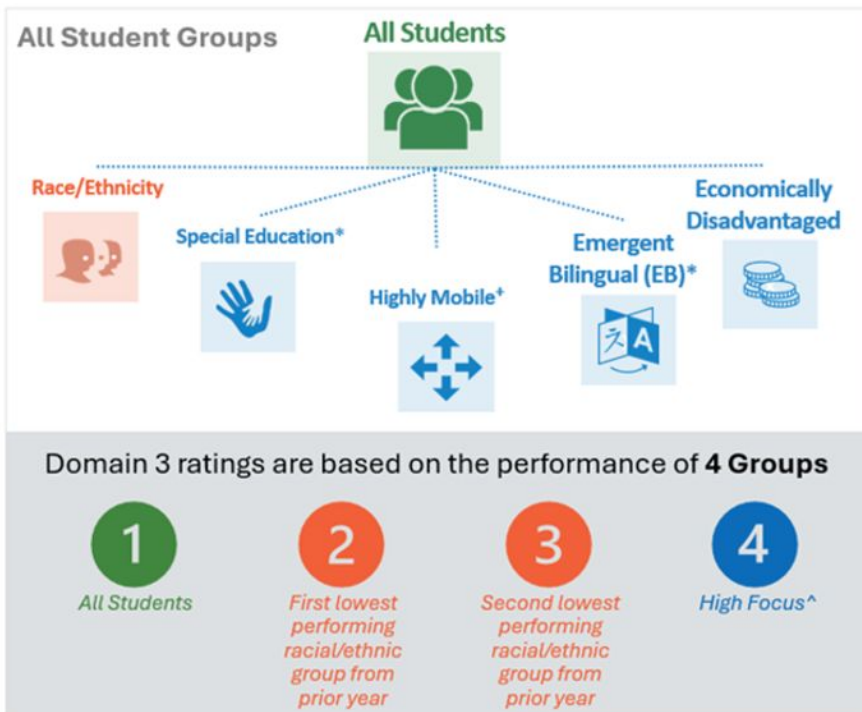

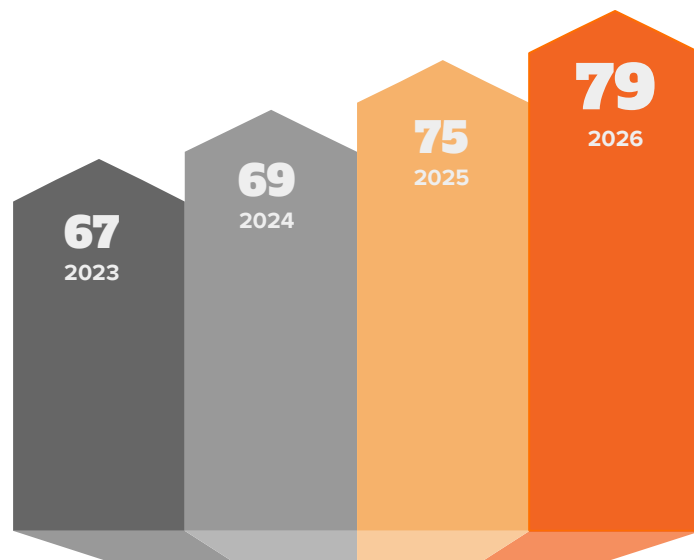
