Dance and AP Art students will collaborate through shared experiences at the Getty, professional workshops, and a Broadway production. California provides access to arts institutions, professionals, and training opportunities not readily available in Utah.

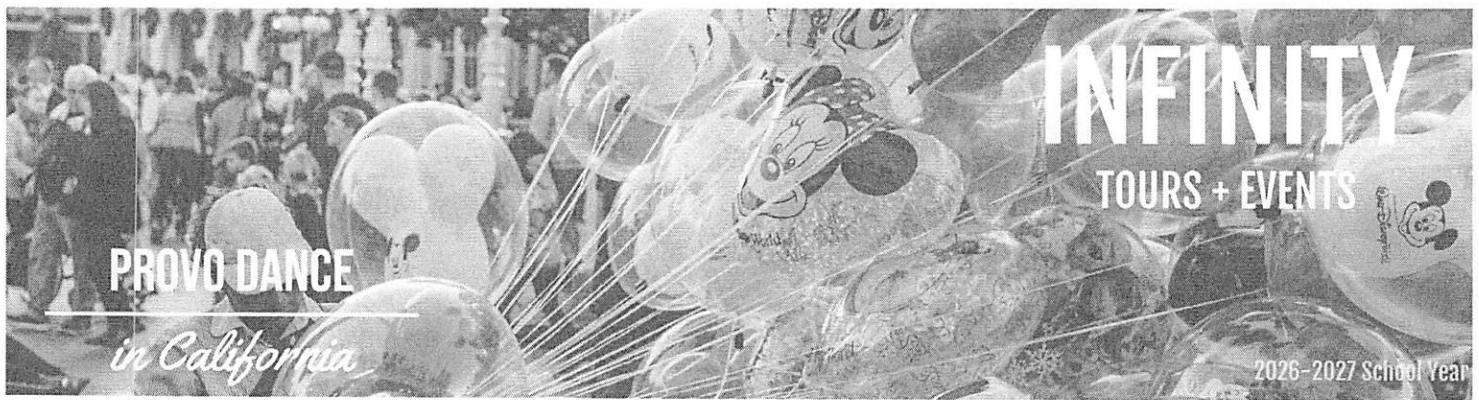
