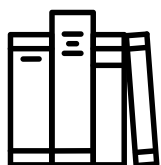

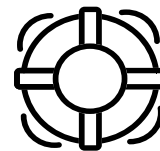

PROPERTY VALUATION

Accurate replacement cost estimates for buildings and contents are essential to maintaining adequate coverage for school assets. With reconstruction costs rising, outdated values can leave a district underinsured and expose the fund balance after a major loss. Life safety and certified playground safety inspections are also available.

We also partner with Hartford Steam Boiler to coordinate required boiler inspections, provide recommendations when needed, and issue certificates—at no additional charge.

For facility safety and security, we can help assess key elements of your security posture. Optional support includes a contracted security audit to assist Texas school districts and junior colleges with the triennial safety and security audit required by TEC 37.108(b).

BUS DRIVER OF THE YEAR

School bus drivers are one of the most important parts of a student's educational experience, yet they don't always get the recognition they deserve. The annual program *Bus Driver of the Year* campaign, administered by INSURICA Education, was established in 2005 to honor school bus drivers who demonstrate outstanding professionalism and safe driving. One driver at each participating Member school district will be honored with a commendation and gift. From those district honorees, one statewide honoree is selected and receives \$2,500, and four regional honorees are selected and each receives \$500.

Members receive free, unlimited access to *Trainery One* streaming safety video service. 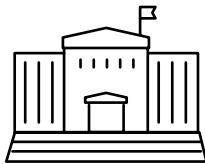

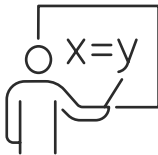
