

STUDENT SAFETY IDENTIFICATION CARDS

The board of education believes that the use of identification cards by students serves to enhance student safety overall school safety and security. Secondary schools (Middle School, Junior High, and High School) Effective with the 2022-2023 school year, identification cards may ~~shall~~ be utilized student identification cards at the discretion of the site building administration. to identify students in secondary schools at the discretion of each school. All identification cards will be clearly marked "FOR INTERNAL USE ONLY" upon the face of the document.

Usage and Replacement

- Display Requirement: In schools that choose to require identification cards, students must wear or display their card above the waistline at all times while on campus or at designated school functions.
- Fees: Initial identification cards will be issued free of charge. Replacement cards will be determined on an annual or site-by-site basis and outlined in the building's student handbook.

Discipline and Compliance

Failure to display or possess a required identification card will result in the issuance of a temporary ID and appropriate consequences, as determined by site administration and outlined in the student handbook.

In schools that choose to require student identification cards, the cards will be utilized to identify students. Students must display identification cards above the waistline at all times. ~~Initial identification cards will be issued free of charge. Replacement identification cards may be subject to a fee.~~ The identification cards will be issued free of charge. However, replacement cards will cost \$6.00 each.

Penalties for failure to display identification cards are:

1. ~~First: warning and temporary identification card issued.~~
2. ~~Subsequent Offense: temporary identification issued and closed campus assigned.~~

Beginning July 1, 2023, student identification cards shall contain the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline, which can be accessed by calling or texting 988 and the Crisis Text Line, which can be accessed by texting HOME to 7417841. If the district has a supply of unissued student identification cards that do not contain the above, the district may issue the non-compliant student identification cards until such supply is depleted.
