Home visits will begin in September.

Priority are students who were enrolled in kindergarten last year, and who haven't enrolled in 1st Grade by Sept. 5th. Second targeted group will be students who were enrolled in Head Start or Little Learners last year, but haven't enrolled in Kindergarten. Third targeted group will be 1st graders and kindergarteners who are in the attendance subgroup (students who have missed 30% of school days).

Graduation Matters

During SBE Week, our teams participated in focused planning and collaboration. Staff became familiar with our new math curriculum, Math & You, and developed project-based learning activities that will integrate science and social studies on Fridays. We will also begin aimswebPlus testing on August 31, 2026, and continue through September 11, 2026.

Culture Matters

Our BNAS staff are working collaboratively to plan meaningful cultural activities for our school. Across the building, staff have been diligently teaching and reinforcing our schoolwide BEAR expectations and behavior-management plans. Teachers are also focused on helping students learn and practice classroom routines, procedures, and expectations to create a safe, positive, and successful learning environment.

We have scheduled our first safety drill of the school year, which will be a fire drill. This drill will allow students and staff to practice evacuation procedures, become familiar with designated exit routes and meeting locations, and understand what to do during an emergency.
