We do have some students who started late, who have said they are transferring but we have not received a release of records form yet, and some who have not made contact, and that has dropped our percentages for the first two weeks of school. We do have 176 students who have 95% or better attendance so far, and 68 of those have perfect attendance. We will begin our SUKAPI student attendance recognition beginning in September. We will have monthly and quarterly attendance incentives for students.

This year we continued 6th grade only on the first day of school. This gave them the opportunity to learn about the school, find all of their classes, meet their teachers, and learn how to open lockers without the upper classes in the building. This helped relieve some anxiety and start the year off on a positive note for them.

We will begin home visits for students who have not yet enrolled/attended school for this year after the labor day weekend.

She has also helped plan and implement professional development for teachers on writing, and vocabulary instruction.

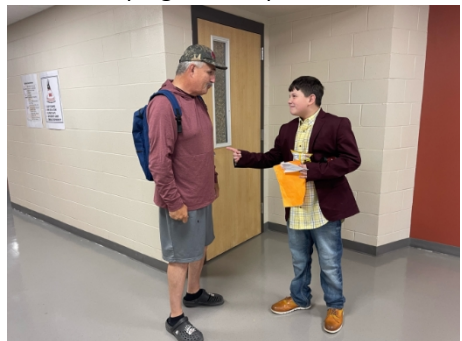
