A Curriculum Committee meeting of the Board of Trustees of Gull Lake Community Schools was held on Friday, August 14, 2026, beginning at 8:04 AM in the Christopher L. Rundle Administration Building.

1. Public Comments: None

2. Draft Minutes: The meeting minutes of July 10, 2026, were approved.

3. Early Childhood Offerings

Child Care/Community Education Coordinator Kelsey Ward and Kellogg Principal Courtney Boyce presented an overview of Gull Lake's early childhood offerings, including Tuition-Based Preschool, the Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP), and Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE). The presentation included enrollment, eligibility criteria, and curriculum. Enhancements made over the past 2.5 years have contributed to improved enrollment and outcomes. Principal Boyce noted that the kindergarten readiness of students participating in these programs has been evident from the first day of kindergarten. The Committee also received information on before- and after-school childcare services provided through Added Advantage Child Care (AACC).

4. GLVP Course Catalog Update 2026-27

The Committee reviewed the addition of the Food Fun, Grades 3-5 course to the 2026-27 GLVP Course Catalog. The course was previously offered during the 2025-26 school year. The addition of Food Fun will be presented to the Board for formal approval.

5. Early Middle College (EMC) Consortium Agreement

The Committee discussed the Early Middle College (EMC) Consortium Agreement. KRESA CTE Early Middle College has undergone redesign and updates to align countywide early middle college programming with the Career Connect Campus and CTE offerings. The agreement allows Gull Lake students to continue accessing Gull Lake Early College and/or KRESA CTE Early Middle College. The agreement will be presented to the Board for approval, allowing Superintendent Bordner to sign the consortium agreement.
