Board Goals for 2023-2028

☐ **Goal 1*:** The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 49% to 60% by June 2024, 65% for 2024-2025, 70% for 2025-2026, 75% for 2026-2027, 80% for 2027-2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**

☐ **Goal 2*:** Increased overall student performance in mathematics to 85% Meets Standard by 2028. The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 53% to 65% by June 2024, 70% for 2024-2025, 75% for 2025-2026, 80% for 2026-2027, 85% for 2027-2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**

☐ **Goal 3*:** The percentage of graduates that meet the criteria for CCMR will increase from 72% to 88% by August 2024 and increase to 95% by 2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**

Summary: **Consider the approval of the following change to EIC Local Policy - Remove “Modified - multiplied by 0.90”.**

Background Information: **The following information was received by TASB during a policy review:**

“EIC(LOCAL): This policy provides that courses that have been modified as to the required content of the Texas Essential Knowledge and

Skills (TEKS) by the student’s admission, review, and dismissal (ARD) committee shall receive a lesser weight than courses that have not been modified. The Office of Civil Rights (OCR) has determined that weighted grade systems that place special education courses alone on the bottom tier of a grading committee scale discriminate based on disability, in violation of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act.”

The district is anticipating the TEA guidance for new Texas universal course weight/GPA calculation that would correct the area of concern. We anticipated a release of this new calculation and mandatory implementation by Texas School districts for this school year but since it has not been released yet, the administration recommends addressing this identified concern through a change to local board policy.

If approved, this would become effective for the 2026=2027 7th grade cohort.
