Weighted Numerical Grade

The District shall categorize and weight eligible courses as Advanced/OnRamps, Dual Credit, Certification/Honors, Regular, and Modified in accordance with provisions of this policy and as designated in appropriate District publications.

Eligible Advanced Placement (AP) and OnRamps dual enrollment courses shall be categorized and weighted as an Advanced courses.

Eligible dual credit courses shall be categorized and weighted as Dual Credit courses.

Eligible certification courses (CTE) and other courses locally designated as Honors shall be categorized and weighted as Certification/Honors courses.

Eligible academic core courses shall be categorized and weighted as Regular courses.

Eligible academic core courses that have been modified as to the required content of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) shall be categorized and weighted as Modified courses.

The District shall assign weights to semester grades, including failing grades, earned in eligible courses and calculate a weighted numerical grade average, in accordance with the following:

Category	Weight
Advanced/OnRamps	Multiplied by 1.13
Dual Credit	Multiplied by 1.10
Certification/Honors	Multiplied by 1.05
Regular	Multiplied by 1.00
Modified	Multiplied by 0.90

The District shall record unweighted numerical grades on student transcripts.

Proposed Change: removing “Modified - multiplied by 0.90”

Category	Weight
Advanced Placement (AP)*	Multiplied by 1.13
OnRamps Dual Enrollment	Multiplied by 1.13
In-Class Dual Credit**	Multiplied by 1.10
Certificate Earning CTE	Multiplied by 1.05
Honors/Pre-AP	Multiplied by 1.05
Regular	Multiplied by 1.00

*Must take the AP Exam to get weighted credit.

**Online Dual Credit courses follow the college grading policy.
