Background Information

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) released STAAR results for High School students in late May and early June for 3rd-8th grade students. Results for 5th- and 8th-grade science were released on July 31st because TEKS revisions in these grade areas affected the assessment content. In the previous board information packet, science scores were not yet available, which is why this final information presentation is being shared.

District and campus administrators, along with teachers and professional staff, continue to disaggregate data to create instructional plans that support individual student needs on our campuses. This 2025-2026 STAAR data shape our district and campus improvement plans. We have many celebrations this year, but also areas of growth. In the 2026-2027 school year, we continue to target middle grades math and social studies as areas of focus. We will also continue to focus on elementary math growth on all campuses.

The slides present a four-year view, which aligns with the STAAR 2.0 test administration. Data is disaggregated by subject, grade, and performance band. Midway continues to perform above the state and region in all subjects. We saw modest gains in most areas, but are excited to see gains in the Masters area of performance in many subjects this year.
