Below are non-action item discussion points that may need future consideration.

Tyson Closure: As we know, on August 13, Tyson announced closure of the Joslin facility, impacting over 2,000 direct jobs. Currently, we have had a small number of (4 at the last count) students leave due to a parent's move for the Tyson-related job closure. Additionally, a handful of families have communicated they plan to leave at semester. We will closely monitor the enrollment impacts.

Link Wi-Fi Consortium: Our agreement with EMSD and Colona school district to provide free Wi-Fi for much of the community is ongoing. However, usage is not what we envisioned when we started. I will share some current usage and financial information and discuss future options.

School Health Link: Veteran BOE members may recall UTHS's affiliation with the School Health Link (Link). UT and Rock Island School District were founding members of this organization in the 1990's. When the Silvis branch closed, UT ended its affiliation with Link. In the past few years, Link started a program in Moline High School, and within the past month, opened a clinic at Rock Island High School.

We have an agreement with Community Health Care (CHC), where they are to provide service on campus. CHC has been short-staffed, so service has been sporadic.

We recently met with a representative from LINK to discuss options, including an on-site provider. There are some details, including outside access, that we would have to negotiate. We will continue the dialogue over the next several months to determine any change in direction for FY28.
