Administrative Recommendation:

That the Wichita Falls Independent School District Board of Trustees approve the resolution authorizing the sale of the District's former Lamar Elementary School property, as submitted by Shannon Troester, Risk and Contract Manager, and as recommended by Dr. Donny Lee, Superintendent of Schools.
