Start of School: We're off to a great start!

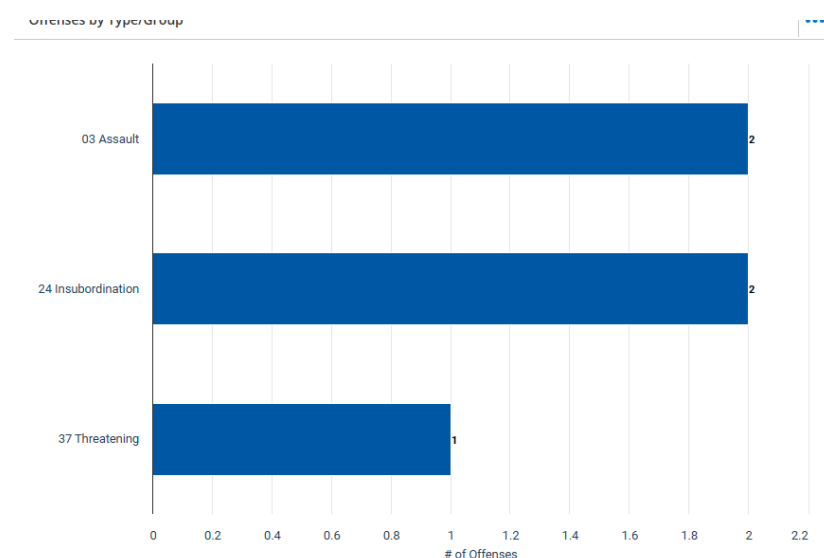
