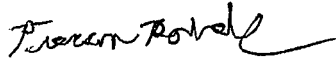
To whom it may concern:

Based on our records, Pierson will need the following to graduate:

- 20 English credits (including English 11 and 12) - currently taking 10 credits
- 5 Speech credits
- 5 Intro to Business credits
- 10 Science credits
- 20 Math credits (5 credits from Personal Finance were used for his finance fitness requirement)
- 20 Social Science credits (including Geography and Government)

This brings the total to 80 credits still needed.

Junior Year: Geometry, Gold Literature, Writing Expository, Intro to Business, PE Gold, Physical Science, Social Skills Gold, Speech, and World Geography

**Credit Recovery (CR) courses are highlighted in yellow. He is working on his CR coursework during off PE days, during breaks and daily at incentive time in ESU2 Independent classrooms.*

Senior Year: Integrated Math, Gold Literature 2, Writing Expository 2, PE Gold, Government, and Social Skills.

Social Studies (40 total): World Geography (10), World History (10), US History (10), and US Government (10)

Intro to Business (5 total): Freshman level course

Speech (5 total): Sophomore level course

Foundations of Computing (5 total): Sophomore level course

Personal Finance (5 total): Junior or Senior level course

In alignment with Logan View School Board Policy 6005, the IEP team has decided to waive the elective credit requirement for Pierson due to his shortened school day while attending ESU 2 Independent. With this adjustment, if Pierson successfully completes all of his junior and senior year coursework and earns the remaining 10 credits through credit recovery, he will be on track to graduate with his cohort in May 2027. This plan allows Pierson to meet the adjusted graduation requirements while continuing to work toward his IEP goals.
