Adopted Levy and Effective Levy

The "adopted levy" is the actual tax rate that the school board discusses and approves publicly each year to meet its budget needs.

State-funded property tax relief programs reduce the amount of school property taxes owed. After these reductions are applied, the remaining tax rate is referred to as the "effective levy", **which represents the actual tax rate paid.**

You see the credits on your personal tax statement.

- The district still receives its full funding based on the adopted levy; the state makes up the difference
- The school district's ability to fund operations is not negatively impacted by the credits
- The levies exclude school bond obligations
- The exact amount of the credit may change annually based on statewide property values and the amount of money the Nebraska Legislature appropriates to the credit funds
