

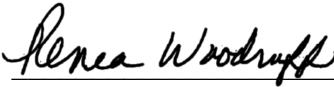

Detail

International Education trips have been scheduled annually for the purpose of allowing students to experience culture and learning experiences outside the United States. Lee College charges each student a \$2.00/semester fee to be used for international travel experiences. This fee funds partial scholarships for students wishing to take international trips with the college; however, it only covers up to 50% of the total trip cost which leaves a large balance for students to cover. Though every student is charged the fee, most lack the monetary resources to participate in international travel.

The future goal is to develop a Study Abroad course. This would place trip fees solely on the students planning to attend and would allow students to earn course credit for international trips.

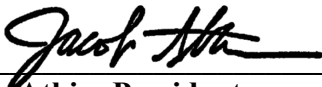

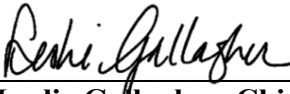
