

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE FRISCO
INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT APPROVING THE PARTNERSHIP
AGREEMENT BETWEEN FRISCO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL
DISTRICT AND COLLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE
DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Texas Government Code §§791.001 et seq. (the "Act") authorize units of local government to enter into interlocal agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Frisco Independent School District (the "District") and Collin County Community College District ("Collin College"), parties to the Partnership Agreement are local government units under the Act; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to reach an agreement with Collin College for the purpose of allowing Frisco ISD students to concurrently enroll in college courses (*i.e.* dual credit); and

WHEREAS, the District wishes to enter into that certain Partnership Agreement for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the District has determined it is in the best interest of the students, parents, and community members of the District to enter into this Partnership Agreement and to adopt this resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
FRISCO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT:**

Section 1: The above and foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this Resolution.

Section 2: That certain Partnership Agreement is hereby accepted and approved in the form attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3: The Board does hereby delegate authority and authorize the Superintendent of Schools to execute and cause to be delivered the Partnership Agreement on behalf of the District.

Section 4: It is officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was considered was open to the public and public notice of the time, place and purposes of the meeting was given and posted as required by Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, as amended.
