Act on Act of approval to seek waiver request from Texas Education Agency (TEA) to provide Remote Homebound Instruction to Regular Education Homebound Student (s).

Item Type: Action Item

Background Information:

Remote homebound instruction means remote instruction in which a student receives individualized instruction through the General Education Homebound (GEH) program in which all requirements of the program are met except for in-person instruction from the homebound teacher.

If your school district provides remote homebound instruction to an eligible regular education student, your district may, with the approval of a waiver request, count the student in attendance for FSP funding purposes provided that all requirements of the homebound program are met except for face-to-face instruction from the homebound teacher.

These waivers will only be granted in extremely severe medical circumstances, and a waiver must be submitted for each individual student.

Instruction for the student in extremely severe medical circumstances, with complications from a serious illness. They are immunosuppressed and must avoid contact with other students and teachers.
