Background Information and Rationale:

- Under provisions of Chapter 1 of the Texas Education Code (TEC) 11.252, every district is required to develop an annual District Improvement Plan (DIP).
- Under BQ (Legal), "A board shall annually approve district and campus performance objectives and shall ensure that the district and campus plans:
 - Are mutually supportive to accomplish the identified objectives; and
 - At a minimum, support the state goals and objectives under the Education Code Chapter 4."
- The DIP and CIPs include updates every November, February, April, and summative updates by August.
- DIP and CIP updates are provided throughout the year in the notes section of the district improvement plan.

Support of Strategic Goals:
