CIP Highlights 2025-26

Student Success:

Goal 1: In grades K-4, at least 58% of students at Lyon County School District will meet or exceed their personal typical growth in math and reading from the Beginning of Year (BOY) assessment to the End of Year (EOY) i-Ready assessment during the 2025-26 school year.

Results: Met Goal

- 66% of our students met their typical growth goal for reading (37% met their stretch growth goal) and 63% of our students met their typical growth in math (30% met their stretch growth goals).

Goal 2: Lyon County School District will increase the total number of K - 12 work-based learning opportunities provided to all students by 10% from the 2024/2025 school year to the 2025/2026 school year.

Goal 3: Lyon County School District will increase the total number of students participating in K-12 work-based learning opportunities by 10% from the 2024/2025 school year to the 2025/2026 school year.

Adult Learning Culture

Goal 1: By May 2026, all EVES students will have achieved mastery (Performance Level 4) of the NEPF instructional practice standard 4 indicator 1, as evidenced by students being able to fully explain student learning goals/targets. Specifically: "What am I learning? Why am I learning it? How will I know I have learned it?"

Connectedness

Goal 1: Lyon County School District will reduce the chronic absenteeism rate by 10% from the 2024/2025 school year rate to the 2025/2026 school year.

- EVES reduced chronic absenteeism by 0.2% from the year before.

Results: Not Met

School Highlights

- East Valley participated in the Fernley STEM Festival. We had all grades participate with whole class entries and our 4th grade students all entered individual projects.
- East Valley held a Career Fair with a little over 20 local businesses or organizations participating.
- Teachers offered 21st Century tutoring with Boys & Girls Club.
- Weekly Spirit Sticks for students and staff based on PBIS weekly focus.
- EVES offered classroom iReady incentives for lessons completed that included several benchmark targets. EVES students passed 24,584 lessons in math and 27,059 lessons in reading.
- 98% Attendance at Parent Conferences – teachers called families who were unable to attend.
- Math Night was hosted by our i-Ready committee and had over 300 people in attendance.
