MASB's 2026 Delegate Assembly will begin **Thursday, October 15, at 7 p.m.** at the Lansing Center. Delegates representing boards of education across the state will decide MASB's positions on a wide variety of issues affecting education.

Below is a link to use to certify the official voting delegates and alternates who will represent your board of education. All delegates and alternates must be school board members. **Only delegates and alternates who were nominated, approved, and certified by their board may offer motions and vote on issues.** However, all school board members may speak on the issues and participate in the debate. Your 2026-2027 MASB dues must be paid in order for a district to participate in the Delegate Assembly.

All delegates must be certified and submitted by Thursday, October 1. A notification message is also being sent to your board president and superintendent. Please ensure that this topic is added to your next board meeting agenda and then complete the form at the link below.
