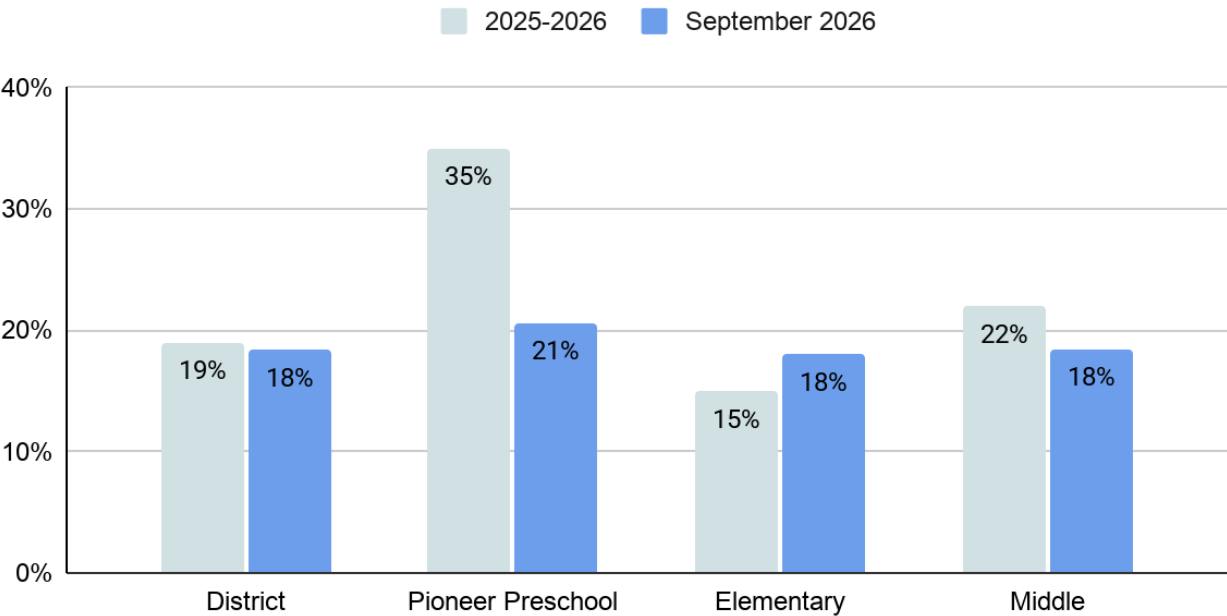
Basic Information/Overview	As of September 11, 2026, we have been in school for 17 days, and the districtwide chronic absenteeism rate is at 19%. At the beginning of the year, the absence rate is a little higher with families returning from summer vacation and starting school on time. We will continue to monitor this each month. Students missing 10% of more of the school days are considered chronically absent. These percentages include both excused and unexcused absences. Please see the following charts for a breakdown by grade-level bands and by each grade level. School attendance teams have been created and are starting to meet at each school. Assistant principals are working with the teams to track and monitor student attendance at the building level. The teams are actively working to monitor attendance, inform families of any attendance concerns, and take the time to support families as needed so students can come to school each day. They also continue to implement school-wide attendance incentives to promote perfect attendance.
Strategic Plan Goal Alignment	Goal 2 - We want all our students to be present so they can engage in meaningful learning experiences throughout the school year. Goal 1 - This will also impact Goal 1 and improving student achievement if students are present for learning each day.
Background or historical information	Our school report cards were published on October 30, 2025. According to the Illinois School Report Card, District 33 had a chronic absenteeism rate of 18.7%, compared to the state average of 25.4%. Our truancy rate was 11.8%, whereas the state average was 19.8%.
