Highlights from 2025-2026

- 63- 8th grade students earned a high school credit for Algebra 1 last year
- 211 students participated athletics at SMS
- We held our 2nd Career Fair with 27 community vendors and 316 8th grade Students participating
- 242 students participated in Gamer's club, 141 students participated in Fishing club, 120 students participated in Homework club, 34 students participated in 3D Printing club, 30 students participated in Drama club
- We had 1054 WBL experiences that our students participated in.
- We ran our 3rd annual Night of the Arts for our Culinary, Art, Woodshop in a box, and Performing Arts (Band and Choir) students to display their talents.
- We had 1 team complete PBL in their classes with 60 students. We are expanding to a second team and will reach 270 students total this year.
- Our Leadership students received The Spirit of Nevada award from NASC.
- We improved our Chronic Absentee rate from 38% to 37%

Silverland Middle School Continuous Improvement Plan Summary for 2026-2027

Goal 1- For grades 7-8, the Lyon County School District will increase the percentage of students demonstrating typical growth in mathematics and reading by 2.5% from the end-of-year results of the 2025/2026 school year to the end-of-year results of the 2026/2027 school year.

Goal 2- By the end of the 2026-2027 school year, Silverland Middle School will increase staff participation in the NV-SCSEL survey from 21% to at least 50%.

Goal 3- Lyon County School District will reduce the chronic absenteeism rate by 2.5% from the 2025/2026 school year to the 2026/2027 school year.
