4.1 College Board National Recognition Programs

Seventy-two District 200 high school students have earned academic honors from the College Board National Recognition Programs. These programs grant high-achieving students academic honors that can be included on college and scholarship applications and connect students with colleges and universities across the country, helping them stand out during the admissions process.

Students are awarded recognition in the following categories: First-Generation Recognition Award, Rural Small-Town Recognition Award, and School Recognition Award. Students who may be eligible must meet the following criteria: Take the PSAT/NMSQT (10th, 11th), PSAT 10 (10th), and/or AP Exams (by the end of 10th); Earn a cumulative GPA of B+ or higher by the time of submission; Be one of the top 10% of test takers from their award program in the state or earn a 3+ on 2 or more distinct AP exams in the 9th and/or 10th grade.
