

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE LAREDO COLLEGE DISTRICT
ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY ANNEXED BY THE CITY OF LAREDO
INTO THE LAREDO COLLEGE DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Laredo College District ("College District") is a public community college district organized and operating under the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Laredo, Texas ("City"), has adopted ordinances altering and extending the corporate boundaries of the City through the annexation of additional territory; and

WHEREAS, City of Laredo Ordinance No. 2026-O-036 annexed approximately 0.25 acres of land, more or less, located south of FM 1472 and east of Iron Mine Road into the corporate limits of the City of Laredo; and

WHEREAS, City of Laredo Ordinance No. 2026-O-037 annexed approximately 59.89 acres of land, more or less, located northeast of FM 1472 and the Max A. Mandel Municipal Golf Course into the corporate limits of the City of Laredo; and

WHEREAS, City of Laredo Ordinance No. 2026-O-038 annexed approximately 13.735 acres of land, more or less, located north of FM 1472 and Ben-Hur Ranch Road into the corporate limits of the City of Laredo; and

WHEREAS, City of Laredo Ordinance No. 2026-O-039 annexed approximately 275.67 acres of land, more or less, located west of IH-35, north of Beltway Parkway, and south of Reuthinger Parkway into the corporate limits of the City of Laredo; and

WHEREAS, City of Laredo Ordinance No. 2026-O-040 annexed approximately 562.7735 acres of land, more or less, located northwest of FM 1472 and FM 3338 into the corporate limits of the City of Laredo; and

WHEREAS, City of Laredo Ordinance No. 2026-O-126 annexed approximately 23.942 acres of land, more or less, located southeast of Cuatro Vientos and Sierra Vista Boulevard into the corporate limits of the City of Laredo; and

WHEREAS, City of Laredo Ordinance No. 2026-O-127 annexed approximately 8.42 acres of land, more or less, located south of FM 1472 and west of Ben-Hur Ranch Road into the corporate limits of the City of Laredo; and

WHEREAS, City of Laredo Ordinance No. 2026-O-128 annexed approximately 5.19 acres of land, more or less, located south of FM 1472 and north of Mercury Mine Road into the corporate limits of the City of Laredo; and

WHEREAS, City of Laredo Ordinance No. 2026-O-129 annexed approximately 150.8236 acres of land, more or less, located northwest of Nicolas D. Hachar Road and River Bank Drive into the corporate limits of the City of Laredo; and

WHEREAS, the territories described in the foregoing City ordinances total approximately 1,100.6941 acres, more or less, and the legal descriptions, metes and bounds, surveys, maps, and other exhibits contained in the respective City ordinances are incorporated herein by reference for purposes of identifying the territories subject to this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that it is appropriate to incorporate the territories annexed by the City of Laredo into the boundaries of the Laredo College District, as authorized and provided by applicable law, and to take such actions as may be necessary to reflect the expanded boundaries of the College District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LAREDO COLLEGE DISTRICT THAT:

SECTION 1. ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY. The Board of Trustees hereby approves the annexation and incorporation into the Laredo College District of the territories annexed into the corporate limits of the City of Laredo pursuant to City of Laredo Ordinance Nos. 2026-O-036, 2026-O-037, 2026-O-038, 2026-O-039, 2026-O-040, 2026-O-126, 2026-O-127, 2026-O-128, and 2026-O-129, subject to and in accordance with applicable law.

SECTION 2. DESCRIPTION OF TERRITORY. The territories annexed into the College District pursuant to this Resolution shall be those territories specifically described by the legal descriptions, metes and bounds, surveys, maps, and exhibits contained in the respective City of Laredo ordinances identified above, which are incorporated into this Resolution by reference as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 3. COLLEGE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES. Upon the effective date of the annexation, the official boundaries of the Laredo College District shall be deemed amended and extended to include the territories described herein, and such territories shall thereafter constitute part of the Laredo College District for all purposes authorized by law.

SECTION 4. AUTHORIZATION TO IMPLEMENT RESOLUTION. The College President, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute, acknowledge, deliver, and file any documents and take any other actions reasonably necessary or appropriate to implement this Resolution, including providing notice or documentation to applicable governmental entities and updating the official records and boundary information of the Laredo College District.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision, section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Trustees, subject to any additional requirements or effective dates established by applicable law.
