AGENDA ITEM: Consider Approval of of Class Size Waiver

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- In accordance with Texas Education Code, districts are required to maintain a student–teacher ratio of 22:1 in kindergarten through fourth grade. When class sizes exceed this ratio, districts must seek a class size waiver from the Texas Education Agency. At this time, several of our elementary classrooms have enrollment numbers above the allowable threshold. While we remain committed to providing students with a high-quality learning environment, factors such as enrollment growth, staffing allocations, and timing of student registration have created the need to request a waiver. Approval of this waiver will ensure we remain in compliance with state requirements while continuing to monitor enrollment and make adjustments to best support our students and teachers.
- The District is seeking the following class size waiver due to increased enrollment:
 - Annetta
 - Fifth Grade: 4 classes at 23, 2 classes at 24
 - Coder
 - First Grade: 2 classes at 23
 - Second Grade: 1 class at 23
 - Fourth Grade: 2 classes at 23
 - McCall
 - Second Grade: 2 classes at 23
 - Lynn McKinney
 - Fifth Grade: 3 classes at 26, 1 class at 27
 - Stuard
 - Third Grade: 1 class at 23
 - Vanda
 - Fourth Grade: 1 class at 23, 3 classes at 24, 1 class at 25
 - Walsh
 - Kindergarten: 2 classes at 23
 - Fourth Grade: 4 classes at 24
