SCHOOL BOARD
AUGUST 19, 2025

Chair Yang called the meeting to order at 6:01 PM with the following present: Chair Yang, Vice Chair C. Anderson, Clerk Livingston, Treasurer Swor, Director Yener and Superintendent Tucci Osorio. Arriving at 6:02 PM Director Rosemark. Absent: Director Nitardy.

Others present were: Andrew Beaton, Assistant Superintendent; Tricia St. Michaels, Assistant Superintendent; Tamra Lennox, Director of Community Education; and May Her, Executive Assistant.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Swor moved and Livingston seconded the following motion, which carried on a 5 – 0 vote:

The Consent Agenda was considered. Swor requested that Item IV.H., Girls Hockey Cooperative, be removed for discussion. Livingston moved and Yener seconded the following resolution, which carried on a 6 – 0 vote:

Beaton discussed the reasoning behind the cooperative. Yener moved and Swor seconded the following resolution, which carried on a 6 – 0 vote:

Nonresident Students); 521 (Student Disability Nondiscrimination); 524 (Internet, Technology, and Cell Phone Acceptable Use and Safety); 613 (Graduation Requirements); 621 (Literacy and The READ Act); 624 (Online Learning Options); 709 (Student Transportation Safety); 721 (Procurement); 722 (Public Data Requests); 806 (Crisis Management). St. Michaels reviewed the following policy proposed for adoption: 625(Responsible Use Of Artificial Intelligence). These policies will have a final reading and will be proposed for action at the September 28 business meeting.

Tucci Osorio provided an update regarding back to school plans.

Anderson moved and Rosemark seconded the following resolution, which carried on a 6 – 0 vote:
