Superintendent Report September - 2026

Facilities:

With our power outage on September 11th due to a broken power line, PUD #3 has been on campus several times along with a utility locating company with a plan to install new ground level electrical vault on campus, new underground power lines, and a new transformer located next to the HS. The utility locate is to determine if the PUD needs to “trench” the new power lines or to “hydraulic” drill the new power lines to the new transformer. Once determined on the install, this work would be done on the weekend or a non-student day since power would be down for several hours.

Danger Tree Removal. We asked Jim Frost back in December of 2025 to mark trees that need to be removed. That count was 21 trees. I have been working with some vendors for a quote to remove the trees, but determining which ones needed to be removed was difficult since the markings have worn off over time. Jim came back on campus and re-marked the trees and determined that another 50 trees should be removed. I have asked Jim Frost to submit a proposal to me to take over the tree removal process, find contractors, permitting, and sale or disposal of the trees.

Field Lighting. We received a quote from PUD #3 to install a transformer along with the quote for the field lighting. I have asked Schumacher Electric for an estimate on the cost of the circuit breaks for the lights.

Metal Shop Roof. Holtzlander is scheduled to be on site the week of Sept 28th weather permitting.
