RE: Disposition of District Property

Recommendation

The District has disposed of 15 carts that were used at the elementary school for storing and charging Chromebooks. These carts were no longer needed with the switch to iPads, they take up a lot of space and some were not working.

Background

Administration is required to notify the board, per Policy 4:80, of District personal property or real estate that is no longer needed for school purposes, so that the Board can consider its disposition. However, the administration may unilaterally dispose of personal property of a diminutive value.

Current Situation

The carts were offered to other school Districts and the three type E carts were given to the Regional Office of Education in Bloomington, IL. The remaining carts were recycled.

Cart type A - 2 carts, working condition
Cart type B - 1 cart, working condition
Cart type C - 4 carts, working condition
Cart type D - 5 carts, not usable to charge
Cart type E - 3 carts, working condition
