Agenda Topic:	Approval of Limited Service Deputy Agreement and Appointment of Employees to act on Behalf of Denton ISD as Deputies with Denton County.
Type of Item:	Consent
Guiding Outcome:	Responsible Fiscal Stewardship
Summary:	This agreement allows Denton County to deputize Denton ISD employees to act as limited service deputies for the purpose of renewing registrations for Denton ISD's fleet through a web-based application. The agreement states the deputies must be DISD employees and designated by the Board.
Background Information/ Previous Board Action:	Denton ISD's current vehicle fleet consists of over 300 units. Each year, we are required to renew registration for each unit. Currently, a DISD employee must appear in person at Denton County's Tax Office to complete the registration(s). We are often limited to 3-5 transactions for each visit. Often, an DISD employee must spend 1-3 hours away from other regular duties to complete these transactions one to two times each month.
Potential Operational Impact:	Approving this process will allow Denton ISD to make better use of our staff resources.
Potential Financial Impact	A nominal change in printing costs and training is expected. The greatest benefit is anticipated in better utilization of staff resources.
Recommendation (Consent or New Business Only):	Approval of the Limited Service Deputy Agreement with Denton County for the purpose of processing vehicle registrations & delegate authority to execute the agreement and process to the Superintendent or Deputy Superintendent.
